





The plan also offers integration of practice experience into courses; apprenticeships that specialize in practice and licensure; and a post-JD experience where graduates may choose to launch a law practice in the Law Center's unique Community Justice Center—an incubator for start-up law firms. Touro Law offers flexible programs to meet the diverse needs of qualified candidates including part time day and evening four and five year programs, a two year accelerated program and a January enrollment option.
